

## Severe Cold Temperature Bus Routes

During the winter, if the temperature or wind chill is at or below  $-15^{\circ}$  then a bus will drive a route in town so students do not have to be exposed very long to the cold temperature. Following is a list of where the bus will pick up students and at approximately what time the stop will be made.
